

September 9, 1981

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, September 9, 1981 at 7:30 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Willis Waybright, carried.

The treasurer's report was approved by motion of Jim Neth, 2nd by Willis Waybright, carried.

The 1968 International dump truck has been repaired and is now back in service.

Bridge - Four (4) logs are sawed and the other two (2) aren't any good. Will be a few weeks before they get more logs.

Roads - Machined Krug, base on King and California Roads. Third week in September machine will be back to put top on.

White Church Road - sealed from bridge out to Barlow Road.

County Aid- to be used for Goulden Road - cut banks and tar and chip.

Dusk to dawn light behind building is out (ZAP!).

Letter was read from SPCA thanking township for contribution.

Letter was also read from Adams County Public Library asking for more money when supervisors make the 1982 budget.

Discussion on whether to put Revenue Sharing money into an investment program.

Henry Berber - has home on a few acres of ground - intersection of Barlow and Orphanage Road. Wants to hook on to his septic system for trailer for his father. Called Sam and asked his advice. Supervisors decided that what is started now could turn into a sticky situation. Snyder to contact Gerber and inform him that the board decided against this.

Should parking lot be paved at this time? Supervisors decided that the base coat could be put down now when machine is here and top coat be done next spring.

(Approximate cost \$5,000.00) This was made into a motion by Waybright, 2nd by Neth, carried.

Meeting adjourned at 8:55 p.m. by motion of Waybright, 2nd by Snyder, carried. Next meeting to be held on October 14, 1981 at 7:30 p.m.
