The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Friday December 12, 1980 at 7:00 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jim Neth, carried.

The bills were approved and the treasurer's report was accepted by motion of Snyder, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Neth, carried.

Letter was read from Diane Werkheiser thanking the supervisors and the Planning Commission for their actions on the sub-division plan approved on her property.

Also a letter was read from Harry Strine submitting his resignation from the LHMA. He stated that this meeting conflicted with other meetings he attends. Jim Neth is to see William Hill about filling this position on the LHMA. He will report on this at the next meeting. ('81-'83).

Letter was read from Penn Dot expressing their appreciation for the courtesy and cooperation extended to them during the course of the state audit. It also stated that during the period under examination, the township conducted a well-managed investment program for their surplus Liquid Fuels Tax Funds. They commended the township officials for their student fiscal policies.

Tim Morgan from Roadite visited with the supervisors and discussed the problem with White Church Road and Yingling Road, but does not know what the problem seems to be with White Church Road. He stated to the supervisors that Roadite will correct these problems at their expense, but will not do so until spring, for obvious reasons.

Chesapeake Chowder House Plans - will take to County Planner and then to Township Planning Commission.

Mr. Tubies commented on Furney Road. Supervisors advised him that they know of the condition of this road and it will be repaired in the spring.

Meeting adjourned at 7:35 p.m. by motion of Neth, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Snyder, carried.
