The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meting on Thursday November 10, 1988 at 7:30 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Wilbur Danner, 2nd by Harry Hilbert, carried.

The treasurer's report was approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried.

A letter was read from Littlestown School District - they now have two way radios so they would appreciate it if the township would keep the trees trimmed so that the aerials don't get bent.

Budd Hallberg and his wife sent the township a letter concerning the fatal accident that occurred along Spangler School Road, close to where they reside. They would like to have 35 MPH speed limit signs erected along this road.

The 1989 budget was tentatively adopted. Taxes on real estate will remain at 2 mills and a \$5.00 per capita tax will remain the same. The budget was \$288,000. Expense with 4683,000 income plus carry over from 1988, with an unappropriated balance at the end of 1989 of \$395,000.

John Clapsaddle presented a sub-division to divide the two homes on his property, supervisors going to have the township engineer give some comments concerning this plan.

Mr. & Mrs. Shultz (Donald & Brenda) of Clapsaddle Road were present to complain about the Racine junk yard next to their property. Supervisors were not aware of the problems with this junk yard. Supervisors will check with Mrs. Racine on the problem. Steve Kelly was present and complained about the Davies junk yard, and the glass and debris that is scattered on the road. He also stated that Davies was using the field opposite the yard which he fenced. Supervisors to instruct Davies to get fence installed around the yard which he is going to be using.
