October 15, 1981

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday, October 15, 1981 at 7:30 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Willis Waybright, carried.

The treasurer's report was accepted by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Waybright, carried. The sub-division plans of Bernard Lenhardt was approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Jim Neth, carried.

The John Sanders plans were approved by motion of Jim Neth, 2nd by Waybright, carried.

Another plan for Wilson Clapsaddle was approved by Waybright, 2nd by Snyder, carried.

A letter was read stating that our County Aid money has been approved and the check will be arriving in the mail very soon.

The Werkheiser Sewage Plans have not been approved by DER.

Letter from Commonwealth of PA was read stating approval of state monies to be used on roads designated by Supervisors.

New Business - Should Mt. Joy Supervisors take over two state roads. These roads being Harney Road and Fish and Game Road. Approximately 31/2 miles. State will put roads in good condition and give township \$1,100.00 per mile (NOW). (This figure could be more.) Or township could take over roads as they are and state would estimate cost of repairing roads and give township the money to repairs. The state will keep the bridges. Supervisors decided they should meet with Charlie Scott and the Germany Township Supervisors to find out some answers. Until that time there will be no action on this proposal.

Tops are on King, Krug, and California Roads. Parking lot paved also. The shoulders must be put on the King, Krug, and California roads and a tile has to be placed close to K. Millers.

Bowers Road - Road will have to be widened if and when school bus travels that road.

Road inspection will be October 24, 1981 at 8:00 a.m.

Letter was read from Penn Twp. stating that they are holding a Sludge Seminar on October 20, 1981 starting at 1:00 p.m.

There was a complaint from Richard Kelly about a neighbor who lives in an adjacent trailer to the property Mr. Kelley just purchased. This trailer has water running out of it continuously and it is causing many problems. Mr. Kelley was advised by the supervisors to check this out with DER.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 p.m. by motion of Neth, 2nd by Waybright, carried. Next meting November 11, 1981 at 7:00 p.m.
