It was decided to keep Wilbur Danner on as a laborer at the same pay rate as the supervisors.

It was decided to give a pay raise to the Planning Commission Secretary Joan Huff. This is \$170.00 per year or \$42.50 per quarter.

The Supervisors will meet on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each month, 7:00 p.m. months of November through April and 7:30 p.m. months of May through October.

The Supervisors also decided to give the secretary a pay raise. This will be \$3700.00 for the year. (Glenn Snyder refrained from discussing and voting on this matter.)

The Board recommended to the auditors that the treasurer's bond be \$100,000.00.
