The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday, October 13, 1988 at 7:30 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Wilbur Danner, carried.

The treasurer's report was approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried.

The Betty Mundorff plans were approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Harry Hilbert, carried.

Received prices from Cargill Salt - delivered in 22 ton lots @ \$37.98, picked up @ \$42.00.

John Schwartz, Mel Durborow and Fred Andrews were present from the Barlow Fire Company and presented their proposed budget for the year 1989.

A letter was read from the County Commissioners stating that there will be a meeting, Wednesday, October 19, at 10 a.m. to discuss development along route 15 when the four-lane highway is finished.

A letter was read from the Soil Conservation Office instructing the supervisors that there will be a meeting on October 25, at 7:30 p.m. at the Cumberland Township Municipal Building.

Maitland Brothers - have requested a building permit for a new building on their property along the Baltimore Pike. After much discussion, the supervisors decided to have the secretary write a letter to Maitland Brothers instructing them that they are in violation of the building permit ordinance and that the office building that they presently occupy does not have a department of labor and industry number on file at the township and the mobile home on their property does not have a building permit issued for that. Before the township will issue a permit for the new building, these problems will have to be solved. Letter to be sent to building permit officer informing him of the supervisors decision.

Revenue Sharing - A motion was made by Snyder, 2nd by Danner to disperse all monies in the Revenue Sharing Account to the four fire companies which serve the township. Secretary will then close the account.

Budget will need to be proposed for the year 1989 at our next meeting.

Kelly was present and was complaining that Mr. Davies junk yard is not in compliance with the township ordinance. Supervisors are going to talk to Mr. Davies and get these problems corrected.
