The Board of supervisors of Mt. Joy Township, Adams Co., Pa held their annual meeting January 3, 1955 at 9 am.

With all members of Board present.

The Sec, then read his report for the year and found a balance of \$2,891.33 in Township account.

Balance in State Fund account \$1,238.10 making a total of \$4,129.43 in hands of Treasurer Jan. 3, 1955.

The supervisors approved same and declared the amount correct. The Board then closed the business absolutely for the year 1954.

The Board then adjourned, the Board then went in session at 9:30 am. reorganization of the board as follows:

Clarence H. Myers, Pres. James Straley, foreman of Sup. The Board then elected L. U. Collins for Sec and Treas. For 1955.

The auditors then in session set the following wages scale. Foreman of Supervisor-\$1.00 per hour, other members of board and labors-.95 cents per hour. Sup attending monthly meetings-\$5.00. The auditors set the amount of Treas. board at \$4,000.00 and further set compensation of Sec. and Treas. at 3% on all money paid out plus any special services. The Sup. set the millage for 1955 at 4 mills on all real estate.

The Board further then laid a per capita tax all residence of said Twp. at \$3.00 each.

The Board set \$2.00 per hour for trucks or tractors hire. The members of the board signed form 965 in regards to the amount of State money spent in 1954 and further authorized Sec. to be sworn to same and file same with the Penna. Depart. Of Highways of Harrisburg.

Further business was tabled to be taken up at a special meeting to be held Jan. 19,1955 at 1 p.m.

Adjourned at 11:30.
