It was decided to retain Wilbur Danner as laborer at the same pay rate as the supervisors.

It was also agreed to pay the janitor the same as last year which was \$150.00 for one year.

Joan Huff was retained as Planning Commission Secretary at a salary of \$170.00 per year. (\$42.50 per quarter.) This is the same rate as last year.

The Secretary's salary was kept the same as the previous year which was \$3700.00 (Glenn Snyder refrained from discussing this issue.)

The board recommended to the auditors that the treasurer's bond be increased to \$125,000.00
