Bid award for tractor and mower: A motion was made to buy the Ford 6610 Tractor from Sibert's Farm Equipment less the 580C Case Tractor at a price of \$9,887.66, motion made by Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Wilbur Danner, carried. It was decided to reject all mower bids and rebid just for mower only to fit the Ford 6610 tractor. IT was moved to rebid a 17 or 18 foot boom mower with a minimum of 50" or maximum of 60" rotary head. Bids to be opened at the February 11 meeting.
