The Supervisors of Mt. Joy Township, Adams County Pa. held their regular reorganization meeting on January 5, 1976 in the election house for the year 1976 at 7:00 p.m., Two Taverns Pa. The meeting opened with the final accounting of the Township Books with the report given on the following accounts:

Meeting date:

1st Friday of each month at 7:00 p.m. EST, 8:00 DST motion made by Waybright and seconded by Danner to except the meeting dates. Meetings to be held in the Election House, Two Taverns.

A motion was made by Willis Waybright and seconded by Clarence H. Myers to increase the tax millage on real estate to 6 mills-5mills for road purposes and 1 mill for Equip. Fund.

Resolution was adopted without any substantial change to retain the \$5.00 per capita tax and ½ on earned income tax of all township taxables.*

A motion was made by Wilbur Danner and seconded by Clarence Myers to pay all outstanding receipts.

The Supervisors agreed to appoint Mrs. Thelma Flewelling, nonmember of the planning board as recording secretary.

A motion was made by Clarence H. Myers and seconded by Willis O. Waybright to increase the Secretary Treasurers salary to \$2,500 for year 1976 plus postage and telephone \$100.00.

The Secretary was authorized to advertise the meeting dates for the Township.

No further business, meeting was adjourned until February 6, 1976 in which the regular meeting will be held in the Election House.
