It was decided to recommend to the auditors that the Treasurer's Bond should remain at \$125,000.00

The treasurer's report was approved by motion of Snyder, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hilbert, carried.

Letter to be sent to residents of the township whom the supervisors believe are eligible for a "junk yard license." Anyone requesting a copy of the ordinance will be charged a fee of \$1.00.

Supervisors to check on John Sanders dump and Allen McDannell's dump, and send letter to them.

Jim Neth made a motion to have an anti-skid and salt storage building build by Floyd Huff, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hilbert, carried.

Snow Plow - Snyder secured a bid of \$2400.00 for a Valk 510 Snow plow from D.W. Miller. Neth made a motion to buy this plow and Hilbert 2<sup>nd</sup> this motion, carried. Supervisors to advertise for sale of the following items:

- 1. Ten-foot York rake
- 2. 7' ARPS blade
- 3. Ground hog post hole digger
- 4. Portable space heater, 97,000 BTU
