

November 14, 1980

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Friday November 14, 1980 at 7:00 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Jim Neth, carried.

The bills and treasurer's report were approved by motion of Snyder, and by Neth, carried.

Mr. Bowling and Mr. Weikert, from Cumberland Township, were present to explain workman's compensation for Barlow Fireman. They said Barlow serves 50% of Mt. Joy Township and the total bill for this compensation is \$3,645.00 Mt. Joy Township's share is \$770.00 Supervisors will take this into consideration.

Junk Yard Ordinance-Sam Teeter explained the ordinance revisions, additions and modifications. After a brief discussion, the supervisors voted on the ordinance as it was advertised. The Junk Yard Ordinance was passed by motion of Jim Neth, 2nd by Glenn Snyder, carried.

Tom Gibbons gave a report on behalf of the LHMA concerning where the sewage system stands at this point. If the O.K. is given by spring, the sewer system should be here by 1985.

A request was made by Mrs. Davies to have Highland Avenue changed to Wolf Hill Road. This was discussed and since there were no comments, either for or against, the name will be left-Highland Avenue.

Jim Neth made a motion to join PSATS UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION GROUP TRUST FUND, 2nd by Snyder, carried.

The preliminary count for the 1980 census count for the 1980 census is 2577 for population and 869 housing units for Mt. Joy Township.

Notice of election certifications was received by the supervisors from the Board of Elections:

"Should two additional supervisors be elected to serve in this Township?"

Results: Yes-282 votes No-535 votes

A motion was made by Neth to adjourn at 8:30 p.m., 2nd by Waybright, carried.
