

RESOLUTION NO. 10 OF 2021

TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT JOY, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ADOPTING AN INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MOUNT JOY TOWNSHIP AND GERMANY TOWNSHIP FOR BRIDGE PROJECT ON ROBERTS ROAD

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 53 Pa.C.S. § 2303, enables municipalities to enter into a cooperative agreements for the provision of municipal services; and

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. §§ 67301(d) and 67332, enables a municipality to jointly cooperate with another municipality in the exercise or the performance of their respective governmental functions, powers or responsibilities, and to enter into agreement with and to contract with another municipality for these purposes and the apportionment of the related costs; and

WHEREAS, Mount Joy Township believes that a construction project related to a bridge spanning Mount Joy and Germany Township will advance the public health, safety and welfare of those using Township roads and the bridge; and

WHEREAS, Mount Joy Township believes that constructing the bridge project as a joint project of Mount Joy Township and Germany Township is in the Township's interests, both fiscal and related to the maintenance and operation of sound bridge infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Mount Joy Township and Germany Township intend to enter into an intermunicipal agreement for a joint construction project related to a bridge on Roberts Road which spans the shared municipal boundaries lines of the Townships and to contract with each other for these purposes and the apportionment of the related construction costs, which agreement is titled "INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN MOUNT JOY AND GERMANY TOWNSHIPS FOR BRIDGE PROJECT," marked as **APPENDIX A** and attached hereto.

NOW BE IT RESOLVED this 18th day of February, 2021, that the Board of Supervisors shall enter into the Intermunicipal Agreement.
