Carol Holtz who lives on White Church Road was present. She complained about the smell from the Lake Heritage sewer system-said it is really bad. Supervisors listened to her and told her she would have to go to DER and talk to them.

A motion was made by Snyder to accept the Luther Schwartz plans, 2nd by Danner, carried.
