A motion was made by Danner to put wallboard on exterior walls of township building only and eliminate it on the interior walls, 2nd by Snyder, carried.

Snyder made a motion to approve Kehr plans, 2nd by Danner, carried. There was some discussion on Gary Koontz's electrical contract for the Township Building. His additional costs for lights are too expensive. Supervisors are to talk to him concerning this matter. Letter was read from DER about sewage wastewater problem in vicinity of Chesapeake Chowder House. Supervisors are to check into this matter.

Secretary to write letter back to James L. Helsel, Realtors from Harrisburg about letter concerning a salvage yard in this township. Would like to know its whereabouts.

Supervisors authorized secretary that she should secure all the necessary books that she needs for the Township.

Secretary was authorized to advertise for bids for on inch top machined on for Mud College Road.
