

November 11, 1987

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday November 11, 1987 at 7:30 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Wilbur Danner, carried.

The treasurer's report was approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried.

The proposed 1988 budget was presented. All taxes will remain same - Real Estate at 2 mills, per capita tax at \$5.00 and Realty Transfer Tax at ½ of 1%. Total budget \$534,430.00, total expenditures \$282,800.00, total unappropriated funds at end of 1988 - \$251,630.00. Budget to be adopted at the December 17, 1987 meeting.

Federal Bridge Inspection - reports on Roberts Road bridge and Low Dutch Road bridge show the bridges in good repair with only a few minor corrections to be made.

Route 15 Bypass - Letter was received from Penn Dot informing township of progress being made on construction.

Ken Dehoff pond - Harry Hilbert spoke with Mr. Dehoff and asked that he raise the bank of the pond 6 inches and Mr. Dehoff says he will not raise the bank,

Tractor - Mower bids - Bids to be advertised for 70 horsepower or bigger tractor and an 18' boom mower. Bids will be accepted for tractor only, mower only, or as a unit. Danner made a motion to advertise for mower and tractor and bids to be opened on December 17, at 7:30 p.m.

Roads - roads have been completed. Berms to be installed within the next few weeks.

Roger Weaver - Roger presented sewer module for the property he has along the Barlow Two Taverns Road. Snyder made motion to accept sewer module and send to DER, 2^{ns} by Hilbert, motion carried.

Barlow fire company presented their 1988 budget.

Hillside Estates - There were three (3) residents present - their concern was road being dusty - would like "Watch Children" and speed signs installed.

Meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
