The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, November 9, 1983 at 7:00 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Jim Neth, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Harry Hilbert, carried.

The treasurer's report and bills to be paid for were approved by motion of Neth, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Glenn Snyder, carried.

The budget from 1984 was tentatively adopted. Millage dropped 1 mill to 4 mills. Secretary instructed to advertise this in the newspaper.

It was discussed about development on Holly Lane (John Sanders property). Supervisors decided that they will no longer accept a CP-2 road, it will now have to be constructed with FB-1 for ID-2. There no longer can be any development until the road is constructed to the above specifications.

SCATCOM - There was some discussion on whether supervisors should sign the ordinance and franchise agreement which will give SCATCOM exclusive franchise in Mt. Joy Township. After this discussion, a motion was made by Snyder to adopt the ordinance and franchise agreement and this motion was seconded by Hilbert, carried.
