3. Gene's Propane Service, LLC, Propane Tank	Quote presented for a 1,000 gal. above ground propane tank. The Twp. is currently paying \$3.699/gal. New rate, once tank is purchased and installed, would be \$2.30/gal. This is a great savings for the Twp. The savings per gal. would pay for purchase of the tank within 2 yrs.
