The Mount Joy Township Supervisors held a special meeting (hearing) at 7:30 P.M. in the Township Municipal Building located at 902 Hoffman Home Road for the purpose of considering conflict of interest charges. All members were present.

Attorney Clayton Wilcox was present representing Sam Dayhoff. Counsel for the Township could not be present due to another commitment.

Chairman Beebe began by questioning if anyone was uncomfortable with him conducting the meeting.

Attorney Wilcox said that there was a question of whether or not Beebe could be impartial.

Beebe explained that the supervisors are required to act on any allegations of impropriety. The issue here to be considered is whether Sam Dayhoff's conduct in the matter of the Ponderosa Trailer Park's request create just cause to remove him from the Planning Commission.

Wilcox said that at an earlier meeting Beebe had made a motion to remove Dayhoff from the Planning Commission. He also questioned statements made in a recent newspaper article.

Following a brief discussion, it was decided that the meeting be continued until another time when counsel for both parties can be in attendance.
