Mr. Updyke moved, seconded by Mr. Clark to authorize the Chairperson to sign all the junkyard licenses. Motion carried unanimously.
- Resolution adopting new fee schedule: Mr. Gormont said when the Board decided to make the change in UCC inspection agency that he polled the Board for approval of the new fee schedule. They need to reaffirm the polling of the UCC inspection fees by resolution No. 12. Mr. Bowman moved, seconded by Mr. Clark, to adopt resolution 12 of 2016. Motion carried unanimously.
- Financial Security Reduction Request-Olswski Tract & Holiday Inn: Mr. Vranich said this is a really small amount for matting steep slopes and erosion work and are requesting a security reduction of \$2,762.10. Mr. Vranich said he has no issue with the reduction amount. Mr. Bowman moved, seconded by Mr. Updyke, to reduce the financial security \$2,762.10 from \$387,539.35 to \$384,777.25. Motion carried unanimously.
