AGRICULTURAL SECURITY AREA MODIFICATIONS AND ADDITIONS:

The Mount Joy Township Board of Supervisors met this date, as publicly advertised, at 7:15 p.m. in the Mount Joy Township Municipal Building, 902 Hoffman Home Road, Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, for a Public Hearing to accept public comment with regard to the proposed modifications and additions to the Township's Agricultural Security Area #1.
