

December 14, 1979

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Friday December 14, 1979 at 7:30 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Wilbur Danner, carried.

Snyder made a motion to re-appoint Floyd Huff to the Planning Commission for a five (5) year term, 2nd by Danner, carried.

Letter was read from Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on the subject of Cutback Asphalt Paving Materials. This regulation takes effect on May 1, 1980 and prohibits the use of cutback asphalt for paving operations between May 1 and October 31 with the exception of certain uses which were listed in the letter.

Township's solicitor, Sam Teeter, was present to discuss the new Junk Yard Ordinance. There were over twenty (20) people present to discuss this ordinance. The discussions and comments lasted for about two (2) hours. Supervisors will take under advisement until a later date.

The Carl Zeigler plans were approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried. The corrections were made prior to this date.

There was discussion on changing fire insurance on township building from Nationwide Insurance to Hockley and O'Donnell. Nationwide is \$629.00 and Hockley's is \$334.00 for building and \$12.00 for contents for a total of \$346.00 for one (1) year. A motion was made by Snyder to change to Hockley and O'Donnell, 2nd by Danner, carried.

Letter was read from SPCA thanking township for their \$75.00 donation to their operation.

Meeting adjourned at 9:45 p.m. by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried.

Next meeting will be on Friday December 28, 1979 for the adoption of 1980 budget.
