

November 6, 1978

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Monday November 6, 1978 at 9:00 a.m. at their new township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

Wilbur Danner made a motion to approve the minutes, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Glen Snyder, carried. Snyder made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and pay bills, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Danner, carried.

The Gilbert Fisher plans were approved by motion of Snyder, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Danner, carried.

The Harry Bowers plans were approved by motion of Snyder, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Danner, carried.

The Hazel Crouse plans were approved by motion of Danner, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Snyder, carried.

A letter was received from the Adams County Commissioners that Robert Gantz has resigned as Assessor of Mt. Joy Twp. In the letter it was stated that Mr. Thomas L. Phillips, Jr. of 78 Heritage Drive, Gettysburg, is interested in filling this position. Snyder is to get in contact with Mr. Phillips concerning this matter. A motion was made by Snyder to accept Mr. Phillips to this position, if he consents, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Danner, carried.

Willis Waybright made a motion to table the matter of sending a contribution to the Gettysburg Recreation Board, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Snyder, carried.

The matter of hiring a janitor for the township building was discussed. It was decided to pay an hourly rate of \$4.40 to whomever does this duty.

A special meeting will be held November 16 at 7:00p.m. for the purpose of meeting with Mr. Phillips, Special Revenue Sharing Hearing and tentatively adopting the 1979 budget.

No further business. A motion was made by Danner to adjourn the meeting at 10:20 a.m., 2<sup>nd</sup> by Snyder carried.
