A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT JOY, ADAMS COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, ADOPTING AN UPDATE TO THE ADAMS COUNTY
MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, natural, technological, and man-made hazards can affect Mount Joy Township; and

WHEREAS, significant structural, historical, and economic losses could result from an occurrence of natural, technological, or man-made hazard events; and

WHEREAS, undertaking mitigation projects during pre-disaster periods could decrease the total losses Mount Joy Township incurs as a result of said hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, Mount Joy Township has a strong interest in reducing losses from future hazard occurrences; and

WHEREAS, a hazard mitigation plan is a federal and state requirement to maintain eligibility for hazard mitigation funding and, by that requirement, must be updated a minimum of every five years; and

WHEREAS, a cooperative, joint effort is a proven, efficient way to plan for and reduce hazard susceptibility in all government jurisdictions in Adams County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, Mount Joy Township previously partnered with Adams County in the preparation and adoption of a multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan known as the Adams County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, Mount Joy Township has partnered with Adams County to update the existing Adams County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan in an effort to further identify,

define, and characterize the hazards affecting the Township as well as to continue identifying and prioritizing projects that could lessen hazard vulnerability.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mount Joy Township Board of Supervisors does hereby adopt the updated Adams County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.


