

January 10, 1991

The Mount Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday, January 10, 1991 at 7:30 p.m. in the Township Municipal Building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes of the December meeting and the January Re-organizational meeting were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Wilbur Danner. Bob Gitt was present and asked that the accidents on Route 97 be noted in the minutes. Those accidents will be noted in these minutes under Floor Comments.

The treasurer's report and Bills to be Paid Report, consisting of \$38,323.29, checks numbered 6068 through 6081 to be paid out of the General Account; and \$2,471.12, checks numbered 992 through 996 to be paid out of the Payroll Account, were approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried.

Subdivision:

-The Subdivision of H. Earl and Doris M. Basehoar property was presented to the Supervisors. Consisting of 37 acres to be divided into 4 lots. The sewer modules are in order and the sewer and water are on-site systems. The Subdivision was approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried.

Correspondence:

- The Chesapeake Bay Currents newsletter was received stressing the importance of wetlands to the Bay Area cleanup.
- A letter was received from the Bureau of Waste Management concerning the revocation of Agricultural Utilization of Sewage Sludge permits for the Ken Dayhoff and R. Deaner farms.
- A notice was received concerning a workshop for the Commercial Drivers Training Test.
- A notice was received concerning a workshop for Secretaries and Administrators.
- A letter was received from the Adams County Commissioners concerning a meeting to be held at the Court House on January 17, 1991 at 1:30 p.m. regarding the Comprehensive Plan. Harry Hilbert and Glenn Snyder will attend.

Old Business:

- Zoning: URDC called today to say that the draft copies of the ordinances are in the mail, and we should be receiving it any day. The board will review it and meet with URDC with any further comments/changes they may have. A public information meeting will be set up at the next regular meeting of the Supervisors.
- There is a problem with water on Spangler Road. The Supervisors have attempted to contact Mr. Bell at PennDot to no avail. A letter will be sent if they do not reach him this week.
- Union Township on Route 194 has installed lights at intersections between Littlestown and Hanover. The Secretary will contact Met Ed to see if it would be feasible to install lights at Route 97 intersections.

Floor Comments:

-Bob Gitt mentioned the concerns school bus drivers have when turning right out of the Hoffman Home Road onto Route 97. Could that bank be cut back? It will be mentioned to Mr. Bell if and when we contact him.

-Steve Kelley complained about the Lester Adams property on Clapsaddle Road. They are leaving their garbage containers on the edge of the road and at times they blow onto the road and cause problems.

-Accidents on Route 97: There was an accident in November close to Bob Gitt's property involving a van going over the embankment.

On December 21, 1990, there was a 2 vehicle accident involving a Pickup Truck and a Pontiac Sunbird.

On December 30, 1990, there was an accident involving a vehicle and a tractor during foggy weather conditions. As a result of that accident there was another accident close to Plunkert Road involving a Pick up and a car.
