

January 11, 1984

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, January 11, 1984 at 7:00 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

There was a correction of the minutes of the previous meeting, township road mileage should have been under state business in lieu of revenue sharing. The minutes were then approved, as corrected by motion of Harry Hilbert, 2nd by Glenn Snyder, carried.

The treasurer's report was approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Hilbert, carried.

The Carl Zeigler plans were tentatively approved, subject to approval by Planning Commission, by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Jim Neth, carried.

Bill Hill presented sub-division plans for the Wastewater Treatment Facilities Site on the Martin property. This was tentatively approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Hilbert, carried. Plan is subject to approval by Planning Commission.

By virtue of a majority vote, the supervisors accepted a bid submitted by Highway Equipment Co. for the purchase of a Clark Michigan 55 wheel loader, by motion of Neth, 2nd by Hilbert, carried with Snyder voting nay.

Snyder commented that the machine does not meet the specs that we used for the bidding, therefore he could not vote in favor of this machine.

Neth stated that he felt the specs were close enough.

Salesman to arrange to have a used machine brought to township until the new machine arrives.

Gilbert Evans will accept appointment to planning commission.

Next meeting will be held on Tuesday, February 7, 1984 at 7:00 p.m.
