The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday February 11, 1988 at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Wilbur Danner, 2nd by Harry Hilbert, carried.

The treasurer's report was approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried.

A motion was made by Snyder, 2nd by Danner to adopt the Ordinance to abandon township road T-412 due to the re-location of the new said portion of road. Ordinance number 2-88. *

Plans for William Bealmear- Plans were approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Hilbert, carried.

Mower bids were as follows:

Shaeffer (Hanover) - \$11,000.00 for 17' A-boom mower installed.

Tom Seibert - \$10,352.10 for A-boom 17' mower installed.

\$11,482.50 for Versa-boom 17' mower installed.

Bids were taken under advisement and will be awarded on or before February 19, 1988.

James Hunt Plans - An 8 lot sub-division of 75.54 acres was approved by Snyder, 2nd by Hilbert, carried.

George Tyler Plans - The plan now has three lots, #3 lot to be added to lot #2 and to remain two lots and can not be further subdivided. On these conditions the plan was approved by Danner, 2nd by Hilbert, carried.

Secretary to contact Skip Hockley and have him to come to the next meeting and review our insurance policy for the renewal.

A letter was received from the Littlestown Rec Board soliciting funds for the 1988 summer program.

A letter from William Himmelreich notifying that he has permission to burn brush and clear debris on his property was read.

Bruce Crouse - A resolution was passed stating that we still honor the sub-division that he failed to record within the three month time period.

Himmelreich property Fran Koch is taking care of the complaint regarding soil erosion on this property.

Steve Kelly brought to the attention of the supervisors that there was garbage being dumped at the end of Clapsaddle Road with the name of Wanda Smith on some of the letters. Also he said there was a trailer moved in along side of the Davies barn.
