The Supervisor's of Mt. Joy Twp., Adams County, Pa. held their regular monthly meeting for March on March 2, 1970 at 7:00 p.m. in the election house, Two Taverns, Pa. All members of the Board were present, Burns, Myers, Waybright. The minutes of the February meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Wolf inquired about receiving funds for damages to his auto as was previously stated in the last meeting on February 2, 1970 and the same answer was give that legal council was working with Insurance co. but had not received a final settlement. Mr. Wolf then asked the secretary for himself to see and inspect the Twp. Books and Records at which time the secretary refused by order of Mr. Daniel E. Teeter, the Twp. Solicitor and Attorney.

Mr. Shanebrook presented to the Supervisor a letter from the Insurance company (Nationwide) asking in detail about claim owing by the Twp., involving his combine, damages to the same while operating on Twp. Rd. (Straley Rd.). The matter to be taken up with Insurance Agent, Don Rohrbaugh.

Mr. Myers asked about Road sign on Rd. if name can be changed from Schwartz Rd. to Myersdale Rd. Mr. Myers was told that Harrisburg would have to be notified and all the records would have to be changed along with the Twp. Rd. maps.

Application is to be filed for County Aid money as soon as the Secretary Receives the proper forms. Word was received that the County Aid funds could be used for snow removal bills due to the heavy snow removal cost incurred this year.
