

March 9, 1983

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, March 9, 1983 at 7:00 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Harry Hilbert, carried.

The treasurer's report and bills to be paid were approved by motion of Jim Neth, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Snyder, carried.

Dawson Harner was present to inquire about set-back lines and distances between mobile homes. Mr. Harner has recently acquired a mobile home park and is interested in enlarging it. Supervisors loaned him a copy of sub-division regulation and he will return this when he is through with it.

Nothing new to report about Adult Book Stores.

Supervisors renewed all insurance policies with the Hockley and O'Donnell Insurance Agency. They also decided to change the Errors and Omissions policy from Bergdale to H & O Agency. There is no difference in premium as both agents deal with the same company. Supervisors decided to change the E & O so that we now have all coverages with the same insurance agency.

Supervisors signed the Gypsy Moth Program agreement.

Resolution adopting the fee schedule for Act 537 for the year 1983 was adopted by motion of Snyder, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hilbert, carried. \*

Letter was read from Harold Gulden stating supervisors did not open his road. He took it upon himself to open the road and sent the township a bill for \$100.00. Supervisors did not authorize him to open the road therefore they felt they owed this man nothing!

The results of a survey done by Penn Dot show that portions of the following roads were found to be below standards for reimbursements: Schottie, Benner, Rock Creek Ford, and Clapsaddle Road. Township will lose a total of 1.81 miles of roads and consequently will lose approximately \$1,000.00 in revenue. Mt. Joy Township has a total of 36.33 miles of roads.
