The Supervisors of Mt. Joy Twp. Adams County, Pa. held their regular monthly for April on April 6, 1970 at 7:00 p.m. in the election house, Two Taverns, Pa. All members were present. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The Secretary has received the application forms for County Aid and is authorized to apply for same from County Commissioners. The amount to receive for the year 1970 is \$2,448.30. Application form #998 for State Aid is also in order and is to be applied on Twp. Roads T-424, approximately 1/2 mile of hard road and T-429 widen same 1.3 miles at a cost of approximately \$8,000.00.

Mr. Dean Shultz, Gettysburg Engineering, was present to discuss plans of drawing up an ordinance of sub-division in Mt. Joy Twp. In order to have a subdivision ordinance the board has to appoint a planning commission consisting of at least 5 members. Names to be submitted and contacted before meeting with Twp. Solicitor Daniel E. Teeter, Esq.

The Supervisors of Mt. Joy Twp. passed a resolution that all property owners before building shall have a perk test. *
