

FEBRUARY 16, 2006 – PUBLIC HEARING:

The Mount Joy Township Board of Supervisors held a Public Hearing this date, as publicly advertised, at 7:00 p.m. in the Mount Joy Township Municipal Building, 902 Hoffman Home Road, Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, with Board Chairman James Waybright presiding. Others in attendance were: Supervisors William Chantelau, George Scott, Samuel Dayhoff, and Harold Kirschner; Solicitor Walton V. Davis; Brenda Constable, Secretary; and Jan Bucher, Stenographer. News Reporters present were Aaron Young (*The Gettysburg Times*); and Meg Bernhardt (*The Evening Sun*).

Mr. Waybright announced that the purpose of the Public Hearing was to accept public comment with regard to a **proposed ordinance amending text in the zoning ordinance to allow townhouses in the SFR1 zoning district**. Mr. Waybright turned the hearing over to Solicitor Davis. Mr. Davis explained the process, with each person needing to give their name and address. He also noted that this hearing was being transcribed by a stenographer.
