

February 25, 1978

A special meeting was held by the Mt. Joy Township Supervisors, Adams Co., Pa. in the election house at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday February 25, 1978 with Supervisor Waybright, Danner and Snyder present.

Bids were opened for a new dump truck and snow plow. The only bid was from Sheets Truck Center, Hanover, Pa. The bid for an International 1800 Loadster with a foot dump body and Valk snow plow was \$19,153.10. A motion by Danner, seconded by Snyder to accept the bid for \$19,153.10 was approved. Delivery is to be made within 90 days.

A motion was made by Snyder and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Danner to elect Glenn Black to a six (6) year term to the Planning Commission. This motion was approved.

Harry Strine was appointed to finish the term of John Turnbaugh on the Lake Heritage Municipal Authority.
