The Sec. was authorized to draw contract up between said supervisors and John S. Teeter and Sons.

Two members of the board and Sec. contacted Mr. John Teeter and Sons upon a definite agreement in regards to stone. The county commissioners agreed to give said Township \$2,157.69 as County Aid.

The board decided that they would use said money on Twp. road #426. The board members signed application papers from commissioners and authorized the Sec. to file same, other routine business was before board and taken care of.
