

March 8, 1990

The Mount Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday March 8, 1990 at 7:30 p.m. at the Township Municipal Building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Harry Hilbert, carried. The bills to be paid report, consisting of \$16,418 to be paid out of the General Account, checks number 5928 through 5892 and \$2,669.87 to be paid out of the Payroll Account, checks numbered 931 through 935, were approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Wilbur Danner, Carried. The Treasurer's report was also present.

The subdivision plan of Kenny Miller on Mud College Road was presented to the Supervisors for approval. The subdivision was approved by Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried.

The subdivision plan of Robert J. and Darlene B. Dayhoff on White Church Road was presented to the Supervisors for approval. There were satisfactory perc, and it was noted that 18 acres are to be subdivided off with the remaining 44 acres to be added to the Samuel Dayhoff farm. The Supervisors noted the possibility of wetlands on this subdivision and suggested to Mr. Dayhoff that he contact someone to verify the wetland area for any future reference. The subdivision was approved by Hilbert, 2nd by Danner, carried. The secretary was instructed to send a letter to the Dayhoffs noting the possibility of the wetland problem.

Motion by Snyder, 2nd by Hilbert that the Secretary be authorized to advertise for bids for the 1990 requirements of Road Oil and Stones. Quantities and specifications to be prepared by the Road Foreman. Open bids will be as of April 12, 1990.

It was noted that Urban Research and Development, the Zoning Contractor, will begin their work on March 19, 1990.

Correspondence:

-News letters were received from Littlestown, Bonneauville, and Barlow Fire Companies. The Supervisors stressed the importance of having your address clearly posted on your mailbox in case of an emergency.

-Letters and miscellaneous information was received from Nancy Smith Taylor.

-Letters from the County Commissioners office asking the Supervisors to appoint a five member board to assist with the Interchange Zoning Ordinance. The Supervisors announced the board as follows: Mr. Francis Codworth, Citizen; Mr. Harry Hilbert, Township Supervisor; Mr. Floyd Huff, Planning Commission; Mr. John Schwartz, Planning Commission; Mr. Richard Munshour, Businessman.

-Letter from AC Office of Planning and Development regarding the update of PennDot Twelve Year Transportation Plan

-Letter stating the fee schedules and resolutions for Gettysburg Engineering. Motion by Snyder to accept fee schedules, 2nd by Hilbert, carried.*

New Business:

-Snyder attended the Comprehensive Plan Meeting. He mention that the turnout was not good but the meeting was productive and they are ready to start the plan.

-DER has set rules and regulations regarding underground storage tanks. Mount Joy Township has such tanks, 550 gallons each, and we have registered them.

-The updating of the subdivision ordinance to comply with Act 170 will be brought before the public on March 22, 1990 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Municipal Building. This public meeting will be advertised.

-The road inspection, which is required by law, will be held the week of March 12th.

Open Floor:

-Mr. Kelly asked about the electric line on Clapsaddle Road. Could we close the road for tow days from the CB Club back for work that is to be done on that road? The Supervisors said it would be OK and they would take care of it.
