

April 8, 1981

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday April 8, 1981 at 7:00 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved as presented by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Willis Waybright, carried.

The treasurer's report and bills to be paid were approved by motion of Waybright and 2nd by Snyder, carried.

The Interim Tax Assessment System was discussed. Most of what township could gain from this system would be approximately \$200.00. A motion was made by Jim Neth that, at the present time. Mt. Joy Township will not participate in the Interim Tax Assessment System, 2nd by Waybright, carried.

A letter was read from the Community Relations Committee - they hold their meeting on the 2nd Thursday of each month at 10 a.m. at the visitor's center. A motion was made by Snyder, that a representative be appointed to attend these meetings to find out what this organization is all about, 2nd by Waybright, carried.

Supervisors reported that a Valk dispensing unit, purchased through D.W. Miller, could be delivered here for \$485.00 and through Valk, Co. it would cost \$500.00. No action was taken on this matter.

County Aid - In the amount of \$2,339.10 (.40 per mile and .50 per person) will be used to resurface Gulden Road.

Letter was read from Littlestown Ambulance Fund - supervisors made annual contribution to the Fire Co.

Letter was read from a Mrs. Sauders of Bendersville complaining about the deplorable condition of Pine Bank Cemetery. Supervisors to contact Historical Society to see if they will maintain the cemetery.

LHMA - Environment Impact Study - Mt. Joy Township's share of these engineering services is \$1,327.10. Snyder tried his best to explain the Gettysburg EIS Study to the persons present in the audience. A motion was made by Snyder and 2nd by Waybright to pay this bill, carried.

Supervisors to price riding mower.
