The Supervisors of Mt. Joy Township, Adams Co. Pa. held a special meeting in the election house at 7:00 p.m. pertaining to the Phase II plan of the Sewage Treatment of the joining municipalities, Gettysburg, Mt. Pleasant, and Union Twp., Cumberland Twp., Mt. Joy Twp., and Lake Heritage.

The Supervisors received the recommendation from Lake Heritage Municipal Authority Re: Gettysburg Area Act 201 Regional Sewage Treatment Planning Study Resolution. The Resolution was read before the Board. Appearing before the board was Mr. Richard Emerson. The Supervisors also were presented a summary of Annual Sewage Rentals of Lake Heritage. Discussion was in length of the Gettysburg Municipal Authority Sewage Treatment Plant Agreement. A vote was taken for or against such plan. A unanimous decision was to go along with Phase II.
