The Mount Joy Township Supervisors held a Conditional Use Hearing on Monday, April 14, 1997 at 7:00 p.m. at the Lake Heritage Community Center regarding the Gettysburg Village Outlet Stores & Festival Center. The meeting was called to order at 7:15 with all members present. Also present were Attorney Henry Heiser and Richard Schmoyer of Adams County Planning and Development.

Attorney Heiser offered a few brief guidelines for the meeting and then recognized representatives from the Boyle Group along with Robert Sharrah.

After brief presentations from Mr. Sharrah and Mr. Boyle, the meeting was opened to the floor so that anyone wishing to offer testimony would have the opportunity to do so. Several local residents spoke of traffic concerns, the possibility of downtown stores becoming vacant, security, noise, glare, trash, water and sewer and other concerns. A complete copy of the transcript from this hearing will be kept on permanent file at the Township office.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:20 p.m.
