The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, April 9, 1986 at the Township Municipal Building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Wilbur Danner, carried.

The treasurer's report was approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried.

Clapsaddle plan for lot #8 - no action will be taken until sewer modules are completed by Sewage Enforcement Officer Dean Shultz.

Plans for King Investment Property of 4.6 acres to be integrated into the present property of Walter Franek, motion made by Hilbert, 2nd by Danner, carried.

Junk Yard inspection was held on March 21, 1986 by the supervisors. Letters to be sent to present junk yard license holders and deficiencies that were found on the properties are to be noted on the letters. In addition Mr. McAlister was sent a letter advising him that he must come in compliance with Mt. Joy Township Junk Yard Ordinance.

Updyke and Miller Roads have now been completed with stone base and bids for FB-1 to go to at our May meeting.

Mr. Jason Bange presented a preliminary plan to sub-divide 5 lots along Bowers Road on his uncle's farm, Aaron Bange. He was told to make the corrections before a final plan is presented.

Mr. Mearns advised the supervisors of the dangerous intersection at Route 97 and Speelman Road. Supervisors to inspect this intersection on their road inspection.
