

May 12, 1982

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, May 12, 1982 at 7:30 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Harry Hilbert, carried.

The treasurer's report was approved by motion of Jim Neth, 2nd by Snyder, carried.

John Schwartz of the County Extension Service spoke on Agricultural Areas. He gave an outline of the qualifications and key features of such an area. He then answered questions from the audience.

County Aid will be \$2,723.60 this year. It is doubtful that we will receive any county aid beyond this year.

Revenue Sharing estimated allocation for the period of 10/1/82 to 9/30//83 will be \$23,636.00.

The Calvin Keefer Property has until June 30, 1982 to complete the following for the mobile home situated on this tract. They must pay application fee for sewage permit, Six percolation holes must be done(the deep probe was previously done), sandmound system must be designed and the system must be installed and final inspection done by June 30, 1982. If this work is not completed by June 30, 1982, the mobile home must be removed from the property.

Intermunicipal Agreement: A motion was made by Neth to adopt the Intermunicipal Agreement as presented with the stipulation that Straban and Mt. Pleasant Townships also adopt this agreement persay. This motion was 2nd by Hilbert, carried.

Reality Transfer Tax: A motion was made by Snyder to tentatively adopt this ordinance, Mt. Joy Township Realty Transfer Tax Ordinance of 1982, 2nd by Neth, carried. This will be formally adopted at a special meeting on May 24, 1982 at 7:30 p.m. at the township municipal building.
