

June 10, 1993

The Mount Joy Twp. Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on June 10, 1993, at 7:30 p.m. in the Twp. Municipal Bldg. located at 902 Hoffman Home Rd., Gettysburg, Pa. All members were present.

The minutes of the last regular monthly meeting, May 13, 1993, were approved by motion of Moul, 2nd by Snyder, motion carried.

The Treasurer's Report and Bills to be Paid Report consisting of \$18,622.50 to be paid out of the General Account, checks 6718 through 6733; and \$1,825.03 to be paid out of the Payroll Account, checks numbered 1211 through 1216 were approved by motion of Moul, 2nd by Snyder, motion carried.

Moul questioned the bill from Countess Gilbert Andrews in the amount of \$501.50. Secretary to write to Countess Gilbert Andrews requesting a more specific itemization of future bills.

Subdivisions:

Harold Goulden - Three lot subdivision; one two-acre lot to be integrated with house at corner of White Church and Goulden Rds. Lot #3 (7.86 ac.) to be integrated with Daisy Leonard's property. Remainder to be retained as one parcel (for golf course). Snyder moved to accept the subdivision plan of three lots, 2nd by Moul, motion carried.

Caroline Scott - Preliminary plan, Form B has been submitted. Going to retain 8.66 acres and buildings. Forty acres will be conveyed to David Reese, who owns land on both sides of the Scott property. Snyder moved to approve the preliminary plan, 2nd by Moul, motion carried.

Road Report:

Township roads have been inspected.

Hillside Estates - Mr. Moul suggest a meeting with property owners to discuss the possibility of curbing. Suggested a letter be sent to the property owners announcing meeting. Twp. will have to get price for curbing before the meeting.

California Rd. is showing cracks and the edges are going off; entire length to be resurfaced. Also, Bowers Rd., entire length and Plunkert Rd. from Twp. line approx. 5/10 mi. Schottie Rd. to receive top and binder.

Snyder will call D. W. Miller about 3' plastic pipe for Barlow-Two Taverns Road.
