

June 13, 1991

The Mount Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on June 13, 1991 at 7:30 p.m. in the Municipal Building located on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes of last months meeting were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Wilbur Danner, carried.

The Treasurer's Report, along with the Bills to be Paid Report, consisting of \$6,911.42 to be paid out of the General Account, checks numbered 6166 through 6173; and \$2,538.20 to be paid out of the Payroll Account, checks numbered 1019 through 1023, were approved by motion of Snyder, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Danner, carried.

New Business:

Bids for FB1 Wearing Course and FB1 Binder:

Motion made by Snyder to award the 1991 Road Bid to Roadite, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Danner, motion carried.

-Received application to acquire liquid fuels monies from the County in the amount of \$2,638.00. Motion made by Snyder to put the monies toward the 1991 paving program and submit the application to the Commissioners, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Danner, carried.

-Richard Kelley was present with a suggested plan to extend the boundary lines on a lot he wishes to purchase on Route 97. The Supervisors would like to see the lines run perpendicular with the road and other adjoining lot lines, keeping all lines straight with no offsets.

-Mr. Speros Marinos was present concerning the Reenactment to be held on the Martin property located behind the High's store on Route 97. Concerns the Supervisors had were with traffic, parking, emergency situation, garbage, and sanitary facilities. The secretary was instructed to put those concerns in writing to Mr. Marinos, with the approval of the Supervisors to the reenactment endeavor.

Old Business:

-The Supervisors met with the HRG Engineer concerning the Traffic Study that is being conducted along Route 97. They will put Traffic Counters on both sides of Route 15 exit ramps and the results will be presented in another meeting scheduled for June 25.

Correspondence:

- Pamphlet received concerning the Budget Crisis of Pennsylvania
- Lake Heritage Municipal Authority's Audit Report was received.

Road Report

- The paver should be on Highland Avenue Road and Krug Road within the next 6 weeks.
- The bridge culverts should be worked on within the next few weeks.
- Considering the price for FB1 Wearing Course and Binder, the Supervisors will look into doing some additional road work.

Miscellaneous:

- The vacating of White Road and Sweatland Road: The hearing for this will take place on June 27, 1991 at 8:00 p.m. at the Municipal Building on Hoffman Home Road.

Zoning:

- A workshop session was held and the public hearing date will be announced at July meeting.

Junk Yard Inspections:

- Mrs. Racine needs to clean up her yard before a license will be issued. Mr. Steve Kelley noted that Moons Imports should be checked, that he keeps more than 10 cars on his lot at one time.

Ag Security Area:

- Anyone interested in signing up for the Ag Security Area should contact the Secretary within the next 60 days.

Floor Comments:

- Steve Kelley - Would it be possible to pave Clapsaddle Road? The school bus will not go back the road. The Supervisors said that work will be done on that road this year.

- Bob Gitt - Asked about the Money Market Accounts being so high. What about putting the money into CD's? The Supervisors answered that the CD's aren't paying as much as the Money Market at this time. If the interest rates go up on CD's this will be considered.

- A question was asked about the property located between Lake Heritage, Route 15, and Hazelbrook Hills. Was it considered Lake Heritage property? That area is in Mount Joy Township and is zoned Rural Residential in the proposed zoning ordinance. It is not part of Lake Heritage.
