

July 11, 1984

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, July, 1984 at 7:30 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Harry Hilbert, carried.

The treasurer's report was approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Jim Neth, carried.

Plans were approved for Wilson Clapsaddle property by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Hilbert, carried.

Subdivision plans for Greenlee were approved by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Hilbert, carried. (This property shall be one parcel hereafter).

Pham Xuam Chieu Plans - lot 3 did not pass perc. Plan approved, subject to satisfactory soil test on lot 3, by motion of Snyder, 2nd by Neth, carried.

James Hunt plans - lot width, depth, ratio too far out of proportion, Dean has not been notified to check percs, did not send sufficient number of copies. Secretary to send letter along with plan to real estate agent. (Mr. O.)

Bill Hill with LHMA on Sludge Ordinance - he would like ordinance to be waived for LH. Dean Shultz was present and he made comments concerning this. Mr. Hill states that approval has been granted as of May 10, 1984 to distribute sludge on the Dayhoff farms. Shultz suggests that Hill give supervisors a letter regarding variances on this ordinance.

Penn Dot - to clean tile at end of Spangler School Road - clean tile - nothing in tile. Dean to give us a grade on this, Snyder will assist him.

WOW plans- plans need to be upgraded, passed module - attach letter to module. Motion to approve updated sewage module; subject to comments by Shultz was made by Snyder, 2nd by Neth, carried.

Secretary to pay Revenue Sharing annual contributions to those designed community organizations as per 1984 budget.

Sludge fees - Shultz to contact Germany Township to see what their fees are.
