

June 27, 1991

The Mount Joy Township Supervisors held a Special Meeting concerning the vacating of Sweatland Road (T408) and White Road (T422) on June 27, 1991 at 8:00 p.m. in the Municipal building located on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present including Attorney Samuel Teeter.

Mrs. Hazel Walker was present to give her consent to the vacating of Sweatland Road (T408) from Route 134 to the center of Rock Creek. Hers is the only property involved and Mrs. Walter is aware that the vacated road will now be considered part of her property.

Mr. Jim Williams gave written consent to the vacating of the portion of White Road that extends from his new development road to the boundary line of LHPOA, Inc. Nancy Smith-Taylor and Don Moul were present representing LHPOA, Inc. stating that they would like the Supervisors to delay their decision for 5 or 6 months until the traffic study of Route 97 is completed. They want to leave White Road open as an option for a second entrance/exit into Lake Heritage. Attorney Teeter and the Supervisors noted that this option is being left open by way of the right-of-way easement Mr. Williams left open at the end of the new White Road located on the entrance road into Lake Heritage. It was also noted that this vacating has been discussed at previous township meetings and there hadn't been any opposition at those meetings. Previously, Lake Heritage was not interested in putting another entrance into Lake Heritage, anywhere.

The Supervisors will proceed with the vacating of White Road, leaving the option open for the 50 foot right-of-way onto Heritage Drive, in the instance that a second road for Lake Heritage is necessary for traffic safety onto Route 97.
