The Mount Joy Township Supervisors held a special meeting on Monday, May 21, 1990 at 7:30 p.m. at the Township Municipal Building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

Business at hand:

Mount Joy Township Waste Storage, Collection, Processing and Disposal Ordinance:

-One concern that was raised was the sludge section of the ordinance. It was noted that Mount Joy Township already has a sludge ordinance, namely Ordinance Number 84-2.  
-Another concern was why were the Supervisors adopting this ordinance now, when the Citizens Group had proposed doing it earlier. The Supervisors stated that they were working on this ordinance for a while and considering all of the proposals that were presented to them. A lot of time was spent collecting the information from different sources. They now have an ordinance which they feel comfortable with.

Motion made by Glenn Snyder: Be it resolved that the Supervisors of Mount Joy Township do hereby adopt this ordinance ("Mount Joy Township Waste Storage, Collecting, Processing and Disposal Ordinance").

Ordinance Number 1.90 adopted by motion of Snyder, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Danner, carried.
