

July 13, 1989

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday, July 13, 1989 at 7:30 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Wilbur Danner, carried.

The treasurer's report, with corrections, was approved by Snyder, 2nd by Danner, carried.

Secretary wrote letter to state concerning the lowering of the speed limit from 55 to 45 from Robert Gitt property in Frogtown to the Two Mile Inn. Received reply from the state that they were doing study of that portion of the road.

State Police fines will be calculated on the 1990 census. Urging the township to make sure that the count is correct.

Shrubbery - On a motion by Hilbert, 2nd by Danner, the supervisors will contact Jim Sterling to install evergreen shrubbery in front of the municipal building with costs not to exceed \$500.00.

Blacktopping driveway - Donald Arentz will install black top and price not to exceed \$4,000.00. Township will buy the material.

Solid Waste - Supervisor attended a meeting on June 28 and will have 90 days to review and comment on the Solid Waste Plan. Supervisors going to have a work session with Sam Teeter to go over the plan.

Marty Miller Sub-division - there was nothing new to report on Marty coming out on the Lake Heritage Road.

Junk Yard License - Charlie Davies and Paul Hollinger have not paid their licenses for 1988 and 1989. Supervisors will instruct the solicitor to write letters to these parties concerned.

Shields complaint - Cathy Gault, special solicitor for the township, is taking legal action against persons who are not hooked to the LHMA sewer system. . Supervisors are considering filing a complaint against Pat Black for discharging sewage on top of the ground. Supervisors are to meet with engineer on the expansion area for the sewer in the near future.

Bridge Inspection - will start in the near future and the county will pick up the tab.

Nothing new to report on the sign for the front of the building.
