

July 14, 1982

The Mt. Joy Township Supervisors held their regular monthly meeting on Wednesday, July 14, 1982 at 7:30 p.m. at the township municipal building on Hoffman Home Road. All members were present.

The minutes were approved by motion of Glenn Snyder, 2nd by Harry Hilbert, carried.

The treasurer's report and bills to be paid were approved by motion of Jim Neth, 2nd by Hilbert, carried.

A resolution accepting and approving the Act 201 Facilities Plan Supplement for Lake Heritage Municipal Authority was presented for adoption. A motion was made to adopt this plan by Snyder, 2nd by Hilbert, carried.*

Secretary to make contributions to SPCA, Rec Boards, Adams County Public Library and Fire Companies.

Hilbert reported that he had received a complaint concerning the thistles at the Met-Ed substation along Route 97 and also about the wild roses growing along township roads. He also stated that there are chemicals on the market to eliminate them. There is presently a house bill #1429 for weed control zones. The weeds to be controlled are not yet decided upon.

Schucharts is now being operated by its former owner, B.C. Schuchart.

Insurance for township employees - The plan which the township now has for its employees is being deleted October 31, 1982. The plan Trustees Insurance Groups is now advising for the township is \$500.00 per person. This is too expensive.

Barlow Road to Orphanage Road now belongs to the township officially.

Long Road - nothing to report. There was a discussion on whether to vacate it or not. Mr. Murren opposed to closing road because he wouldn't have access to his field. Harry to go see the Schwartz's about this.

Motion to adjourn at 8:50 p.m. by Neth, 2nd by Snyder, carried.
