Fee Schedule for Sewage Facilities Act (Act 537)

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR  
ADMINISTRATION OF THE SEWAGE FACILITIES ACT (ACT 537) AND  
THE APPOINTMENT OF SEWAGE ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO ISSUE  
SEWAGE PERMITS IN MT. JOY TOWNSHIP FOR 1990.

Now, then, therefore be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Mount Joy Township that in a stated meeting on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March 1990 do hereby appoint Dean A. Shultz (#00001) as Sewage Enforcement Officer and Debbie L. Galbo (#02032) as his assistant and as alternate Sewage Enforcement Officer for the year 1990.

And further be it resolved that the fee schedule for the administration of Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act (Act 537) for 1990 to be adopted as follows:

Application Fee for all new systems-----\$80.00

- (a) This fee entitles the applicant to a site investigation, test pit analysis (maximum of three per lot), certification of percolation tests and the officer processing the application.
- (b) Any evaluation requiring additional field investigations beyond the initial visits to the site stipulated above will require the following fees:

- (1) For each additional visit to the site-----\$40.00
- (2) For each additional test pit over two-----\$20.00

(c) If the test pit is not dug when the Sewage Enforcement Officer is notified to inspect the site, or percolation tests are to be reconducted the application will pay the fee for an additional visit to the site.

Permit Fee for all single family residents utilizing a conventional system. This includes final inspection of the system (1 trip)-----\$50.00

Permit Fee for all single family residents utilizing low pressure system. This includes inspection of the system (up to 2 trips)-----\$90.00

Permit Fee for holding tanks-----\$40.00

(If additional trips to the site are required for inspections over that indicated, the cost per trip will be \$40.00)

Permit Fee for all multi-family, commercial, institutional or other applications will be based on the size of the sub-surface disposal system.

Conventional System

- (a) 150 sq. ft. to 1000 sq. ft. -----\$50.00

- (b) 1000 sq. ft. to 2500 sq. ft. -----\$100.00
- (c) 2500 sq. ft. to 5000 sq. ft. -----\$200.00
- (d) 5000 sq. ft. to 10,000 sq. ft. -----\$300.00

Low Pressure System

- (a) 105 sq. ft. to 1000 sq. ft. -----\$90.00
- (b) 1000 sq. ft. to 2500 sq. ft. -----\$140.00
- (c) 2500 sq. ft. to 5000 sq. ft. -----\$250.00
- (d) 5000 sq. ft. to 10,000 sq. ft. -----\$350.00

Inspection Fees- The cost of final inspection is included in the permit fee. If the system is not ready for inspection when notified, or corrections must be made, a fee of \$40.00 will be charged for each additional trip to the site.

Transfer of application and/or permit for conventional system-----\$80.00  
 Transfer of application and/or permit for Low Pressure system-----\$125.00

Alternates to existing systems not requiring soil tests-----\$60.00

Fee for conducting soil tests on a subdivision or land development. This covers evaluation of test pits (maximum of three per lot), certification of percolation tests, and preparation of soil test reports per lot-----\$150.00

Any evaluation requiring additional field investigation beyond the initial visits to the site stipulated above will require the following fees:

- (a) For each additional test pit per lot over the initial two-----\$30.00
- (b) For each additional visit to the site-----\$50.00
- (c) If the test pit is not dug when the Sewage Enforcement Officer is notified to inspect site, or percolation tests are to be reconducted the applicant will pay the fee for an additional visit to the site.

Fee for review of Act 537 planning modules for all residential lots will be \$30.00 for first lot and \$15.00 for each additional lot. For all other reviews; industrial, commercial, institutional, and other facilities will require fees commensurate with the work performed as determined by the municipality.

Fee for researching files and providing copies of soil reports to persons requesting copies of soil reports for lots previously tested-----\$10.00
