Resolution

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING THE ACCUMULATION, COLLECTION AND DUMPING OF GARBAGE, REFUSE AND RUBBISH IN MOUNT JOY TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AND THE ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF PUBLIC OR PRIVATE DUMPS THEREIN, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES.

The Board of Supervisors of Mount Joy Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. No person, association, firm or corporation shall hereafter accumulate, collect or dump, nor shall he, they or it permit the accumulation, collection or dumping of any garbage, offal, carcass, refuse, and/or rubbish of any type or kind whatever on any private or public property, including roads and highways in Mount Joy Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, nor keep or suffer the same to remain on any public or private property therein owned, leased or otherwise occupied and/or controlled by him, them or it. No area, part or parcel of land within the Township, public or private, shall be used for the above prohibited purposes and acts; nor shall any garbage, offal, carcass, refuse or rubbish of any kind or nature whatever be transported in any manner over the public roads or highways in said Township for the purpose of dumping or accumulation within the Township.

Section 2. Any person, association, firm or corporation who or which shall violate any of the provisions of this Resolution shall, upon summary conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00, and costs of prosecution, and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment not more than ten days for each offense; provided, however, that each day's continuance of a violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. Each prohibited act and each of the other provisions of this Resolution is intended as independent and severable: and should any one or more of its provisions be declared invalid, the remaining portions shall continue in force and effect.
