Resolution No. 2-82
Bridge Reinspection Program

EXPRESSING INTEREST IN THE BRIDGE REINSPECTION PROGRAM OF
THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AS
ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE FEDERAL
TRANSPORTATION ACT.

WHEREAS, Section 144 of the Transportation Act mandates that all structures on the Public Highway System with a span length of twenty (20) feet or greater, shall be inspected every two years and that Federal monies in the amount of Eighty (80) percentum of the cost for said inspections will be provided; and

WHEREAS, the County of Adams has agreed to administer the reinspection program for the several municipalities within said County and to provide Twenty (20) percentum of the cost for said inspections; and

WHEREAS, the Township has a bridge(s) which meets the minimum twenty (20) foot span length requirement and inclusion of said bridge(s) in the inspection program will be at no expense to the Township.

NOW, T HEREFOR E, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Mount Joy Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same; That:

Section I. The Township does hereby express its intent to participate in the Bridge Reinspection Program and hereby authorizes the County to include the bridge(s) as listed on Attachment Number One (1) in the county-wide inspection contract and to prepare all necessary documents and to enter not such Agreements as may be required with the understanding there will be no expense to the Township.

Section 2. The Township understands that participation in the inspection program does not obligate the County to provide any monies for reconstruction or repair of any bridge(s) inspected.
