RESOLUTION 2000 – 0217

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT JOY, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURE TO DISPOSE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE TOWNSHIP HAVING INDIVIDUAL AND AGGREGATE VALUES OF LESS THAN ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00)

WHEREAS, from time to time the Township of Mount Joy, Adams county, Pennsylvania ("Township") has items of personal property that it no longer needs or desires to retain;

WHEREAS, such property often has a value, individually and in the aggregate, of less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00);

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code permits the Township to establish by Resolution a procedure for the disposition of such property without further formal action by the Board of Supervisors;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that whenever the Township has personal property which is valued at less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each piece or for a lot of such pieces, which property is no longer needed by the Township and is no longer desired to be retained, and whenever the Board of Supervisors has seen a list of such property to be disposed of and has not directed that such property be retained, then the property may be delivered to a public auctioneer (Who is licensed to conduct auctions in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania) for sale. The proceeds of such sale, less the costs of sale, shall be turned over to the Township Treasurer.
